SEPHIRA

The period of Sephirat Ha Omer is a period of Jewish national mourning, for it was during this period that the students of Rabbi Akiva were decimated by a plague apparently during the tragic period of the rebellion of Bar Kochba against Rome. The rebellion of the Jews was put down with severity. Jerusalem was converted into a pagan city and the Jews were driven out of Judea.

On Lag B'Omer, the 33rd day of the counting of the Omer, the plague afflicting the students of Rabbi Akiva remitted and as a consequence this day became a day of joy.

During the Omer period we are forbidden to cut our hair and celebrate weddings. On Lag B'Omer all this becomes permissible. There are several alternate customs regarding mourning observances with conclusion of Pesach and Lag B'Omer. Another custom begins the mourning period with Rosh Chodesh Iyar and concludes it with the second day of Sivan.

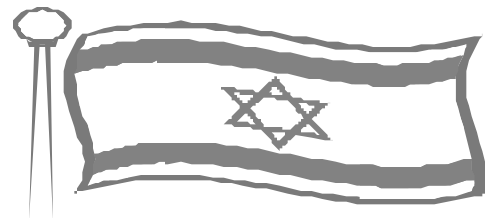
ISRAEL INDEPENDENCE DAY

We live at a time when two of our mourning days of Sephirah have been turned into days of our joy; Yom Ha Atsmut and Yom Yerushalayim. In accordance with P'sak of the Chief Rabbinate of Israel, we shall recite Hallel in the morning service. As a sign of joy and thankfulness that we have been zocheh to see the rebuilding of our homeland in our lifetime, we invite all our members to join us for the morning service to recite Hallel. May we see peace in our homeland. Yom Ha Atsmut will occur on Wednesday, May 3rd.



YOM YERUSHALAYIM: Day of the Liberation of Jerusalem

Jerusalem was liberated on Iyar 28 in 1967. This year Yom Yerushalayim will be celebrated on Friday, May 26.



LAG B'OMER



Lag B'omer will occur Tuesday, May 16th. On this day we are permitted to celebrate weddings and other Semachot. Tachanun is not recited.



Pesach Sheni

Pesach Sheni occurs on the 14th day of Iyar. When the Temple stood, those who were unable to offer the Korban Pesach on Erav Pesach either because they were ritually impure or outside of the environs of the Temple Mount area at the time, could offer Korban Pesach on Pesach Sheni. It is customary to serve Matzah at the table on this day. We do not recite Tachanun. This year Pesach Sheni will be on Friday, May 2nd.
