FROM OUR RABBI...



Mar Heshvan

The months of the Jewish calendar are either 29 or 30 days. Tishrei, the month of the High Holy days, is always 30 days. If the ordinary sequence is followed, Mar Heshvan would be 29 days. However, Mar Heshvan and Kislev are variable months. This year Mar Heshvan is 30 days in length as is Kislev. When this occurs the year is called Sh'leimah or "complete" for it has the maximum number of days possible in a regular (non-leap) year - 355 days.

Jewish calendar years are usually denoted in terms of the day of Rosh Hashana, the Mar Heshvan - Kislev sequence, and the first day of Pesach. According to this scheme, this year is designated - זש"ג - which is to say; א - Rosh Hashana occurred on Shabbat, the seventh day; ח - the year is שלמה - sh'leimah or "complete;" ג - Pesach will occur on Tuesday, the third day of the week.
